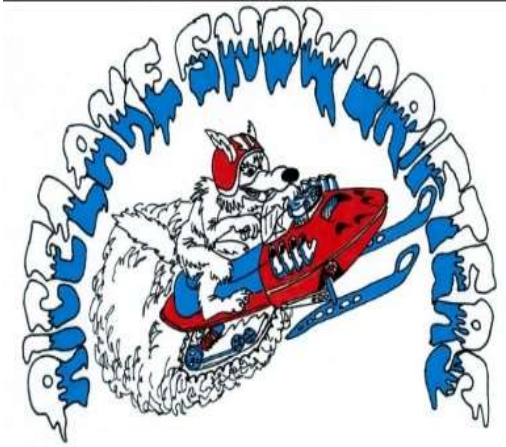

Permits are on sale **online only** as of October 1<sup>st</sup>. The prices are as follows:

**Seasonal Permits:**

Until November 1<sup>st</sup> \$190 plus \$7.50 processing fee

November 2<sup>nd</sup> – December 1<sup>st</sup> - \$220 plus \$7.50 processing fee

December 2<sup>nd</sup> on - \$270 plus \$7.50 processing fee

Classic Permits (1999 or older):

Until December 1<sup>st</sup> - \$150 plus \$7.50 processing fee

December 2<sup>nd</sup> on - - \$180 plus \$7.50 processing fee

Multi Day Permits (2 consecutive day minimum) - \$35 per day
